NOTICE

- Take care not to damage the painted surfaces of the motorcycle.

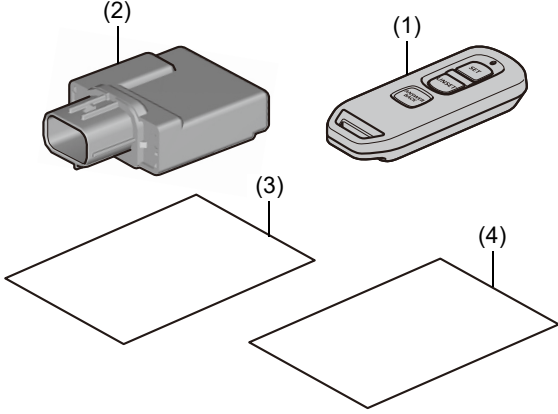
NOTE:

- Heat the bonding surfaces with a hair dryer if the ambient air temperature is below 21°C (70°F).
- The adhesive reaches full strength in 72 hours. Wait at least 24 hours before riding your motorcycle.
- Disconnect the negative (–) cable from the battery before installing this accessory.
- Reinstall the removed parts on the motorcycle and make sure that wires and harnesses are not pinched.
- After reconnecting the battery, refer to the motorcycle Owner's Manual and set the meter.
- After this accessory installation, check the lights (e.g. right/left turn signal lights and brake lights) for proper operation.
- Save all removed parts unless otherwise indicated.

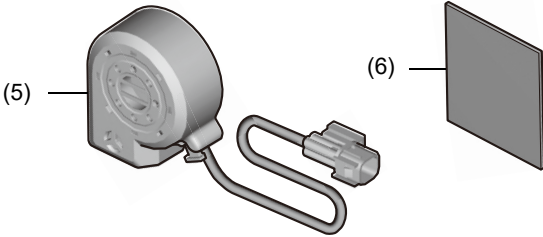

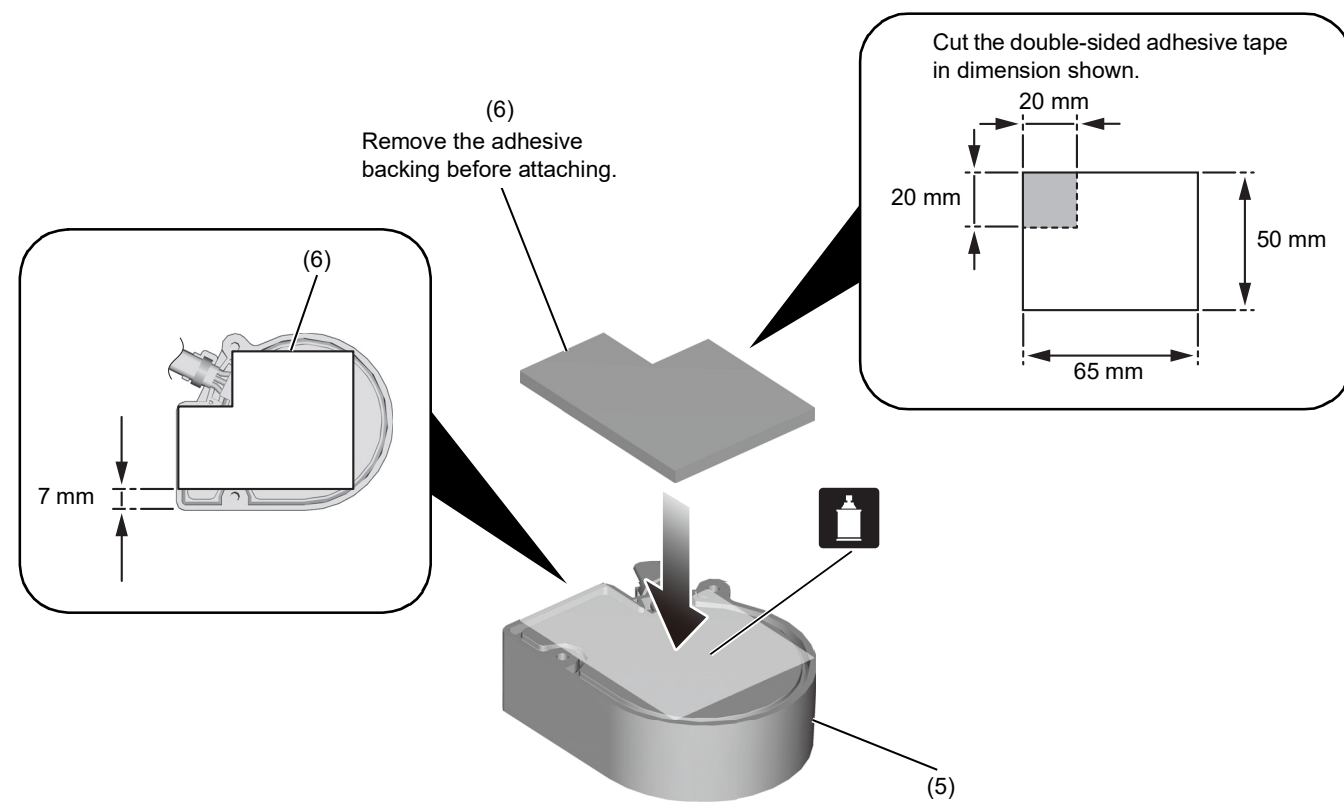
1. Refer to the Service Manual for motorcycle, remove the motorcycle parts as shown, and disconnect the negative (–) cable from the battery. (📖)



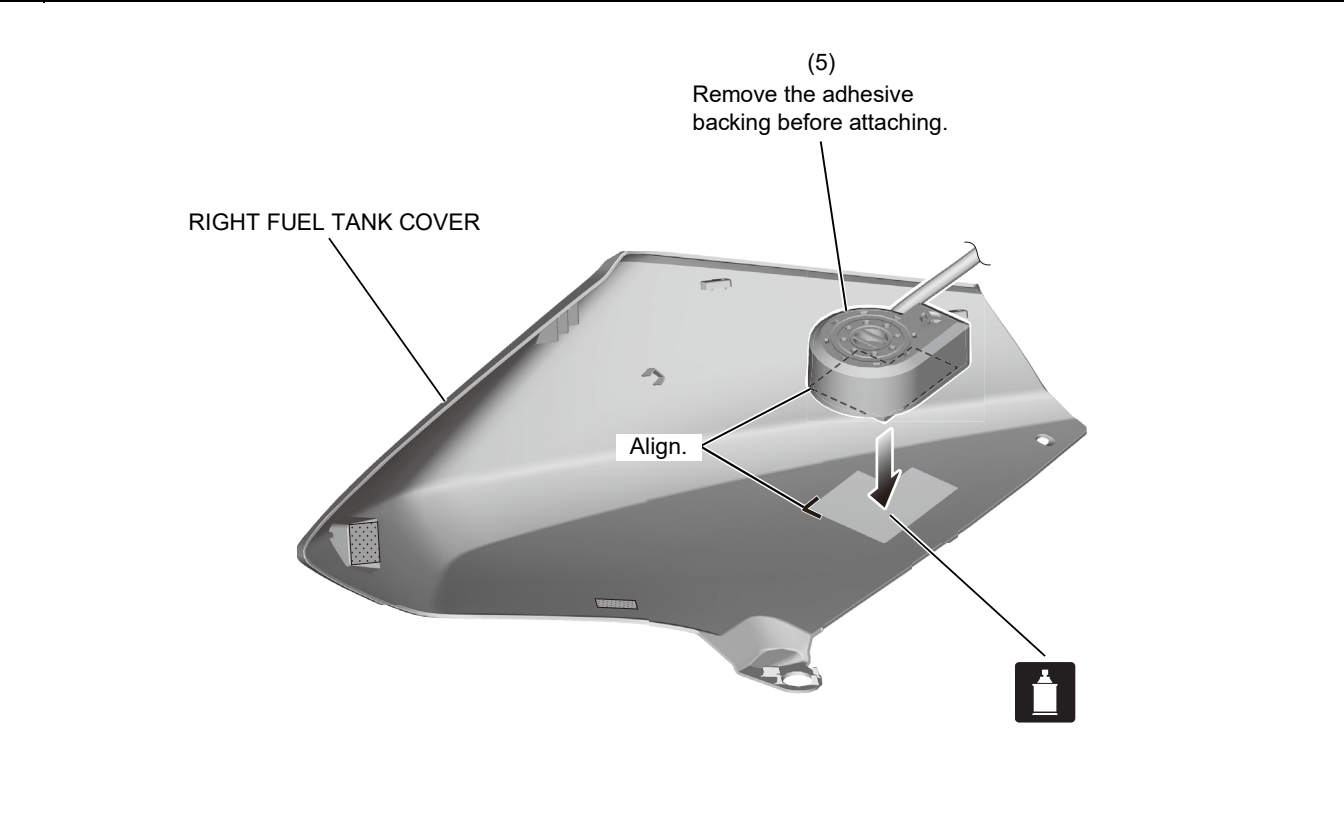

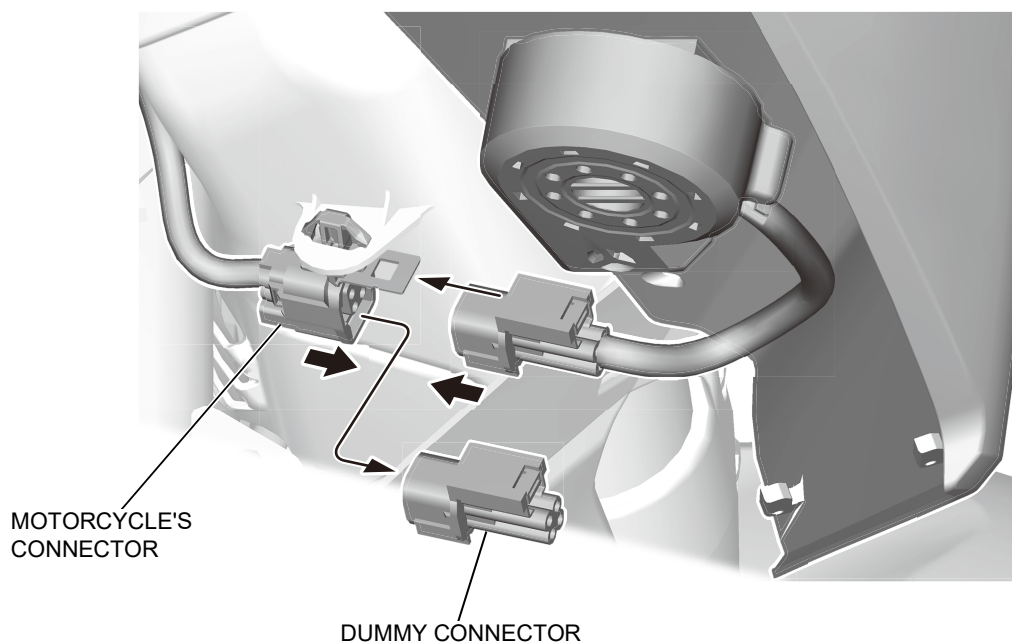

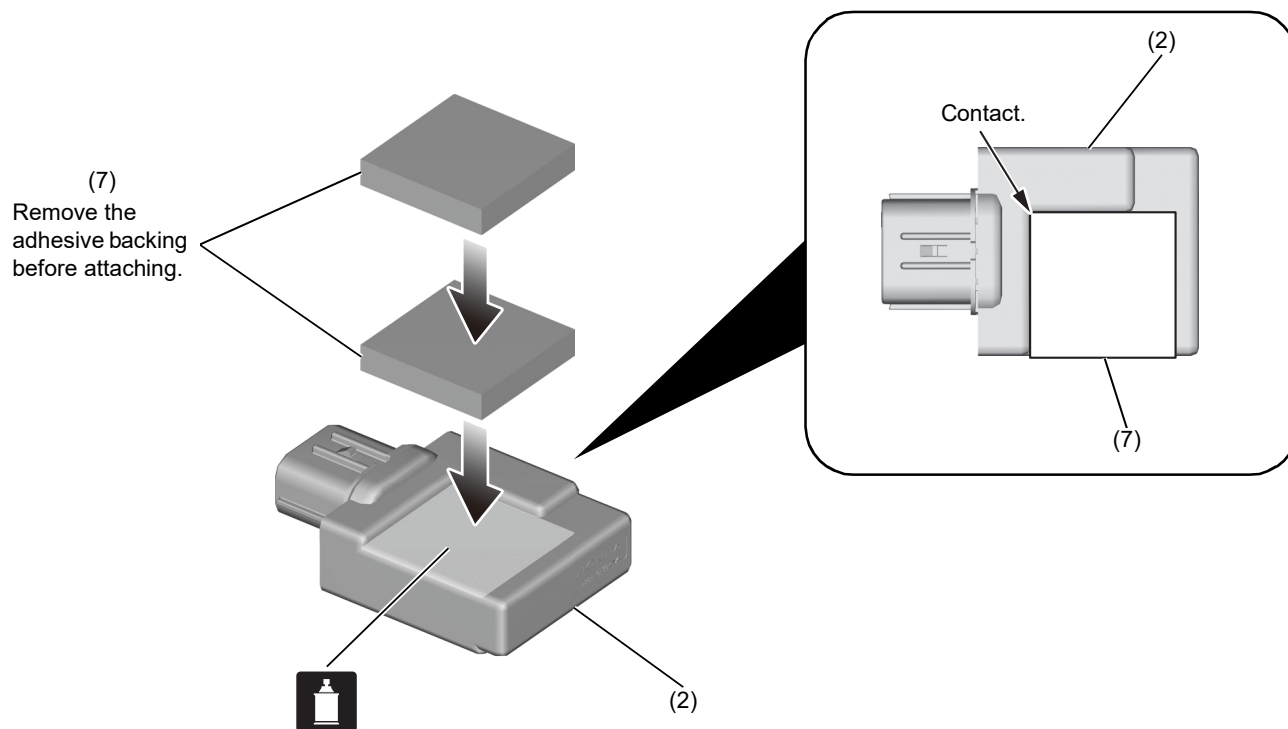

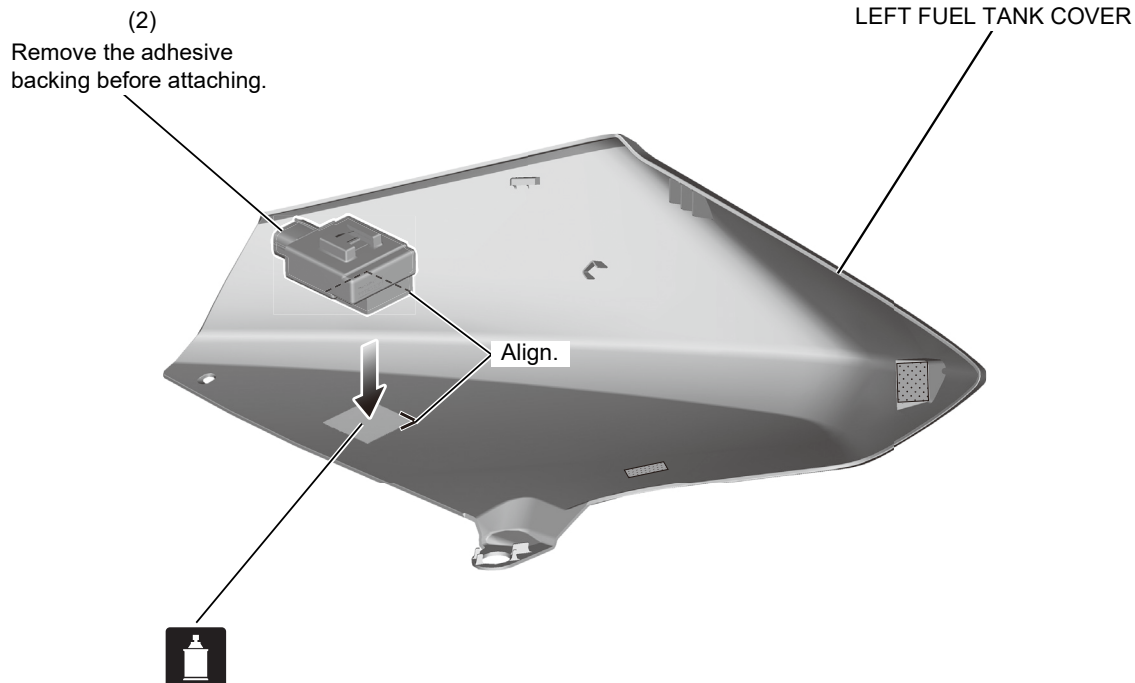
4. Route and connect the harness as shown.



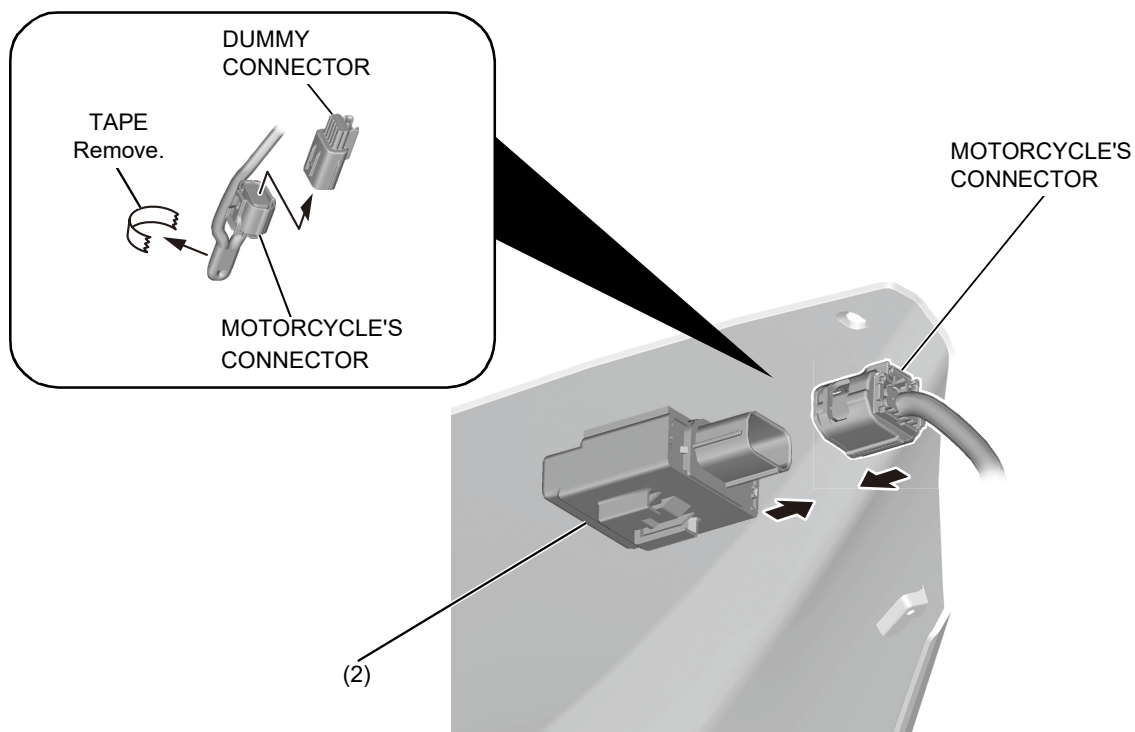
